Hawthorn Class : Visit to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2018

As part of our creative curriculum, we have arranged a visit to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park. Our main focus will be studying the sculptures of Henry Moore and Barbara Hepworth and we will also take part in different workshops. During the morning we will be taken on a creative journey through the park with an artist and after lunch we will take part in the Outdoor Sculpture Building Workshop to create large-scale constructions.

The trip takes place on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July. The coach will leave school at **9.00am prompt**, please make sure that the children are in school **by 8.45am**. We will return to school for **3.15pm**.

Children should wear their school jumper but may wear casual trousers. As the weather can be unpredictable, please ensure your child has a waterproof coat and suitable footwear for walking round the park. Also, if necessary, please apply sunscreen before your child comes to school. The children will require a packed lunch on the day and please make sure your child has their water bottle with them.

To cover the cost of the coach and the Sculpture Park, we are asking for a voluntary donation of £13.00 per child for this visit. We are grateful to the PTA for their contribution towards subsidising the cost of educational visits.

This visit is organised under the school's Visits Policy. Payment and consent can be made at ParentPay <u>www.parentpay.com</u>, if using this method you **do not** need to complete the paper consent form attached to this letter. If you have not yet registered for ParentPay, please contact the school office and we will send you login details.

If unable to pay by ParentPay please send a cheque (made payable to Hookstone Chase Primary School) or cash in a named envelope and complete the Parental Consent Form attached. All payments and slips must be received by **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June**.

Please note that we are no longer required to issue Medical Consent Forms for each individual visit. The information will be taken from details that you have previously given to school. Therefore it is important that you inform school of any changes to your contact details and your child's health.
