In Maths we aim to link it where possible to our topic and life experiences. In all aspects we will be looking at problem solving and reasoning.

- Reading and writing numbers up to 100 in numbers and words.
- Recognising the value of each digit in two digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting numbers using practical equipment and number lines.
- Learning our number facts to 100 for instant recall.
- Talking about the properties of different shapes and comparing these to everyday objects.
- Looking at the value of different types of money and finding different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts.

In **English** we will be basing our learning on exciting stories about animals. Your child will also be developing their skills in these areas:

- Writing sentences using capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.
- Identifying and using nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Joining letters using cursive handwriting.
- Using and, because, if and but to join sentences.

We have a daily focussed phonics session where children will revise and learn new sounds. Children will be investigating narrative and nonfiction styles of writing.
