In **Maths** we aim to link it where possible to our topic and life experiences. In all aspects we will be looking at problem solving and reasoning.

- Writing our numbers correctly.
- Counting forwards and backwards to 20 and beyond.
- Using numbers to twenty and understanding the value of each digit.
- Saying what is one more or less than a given number.
- Adding and subtracting numbers using practical equipment and on a number lines.
- Learning our number facts for different ways of making ten.
- Recognising and naming different shapes.
- Looking at the value of different types of money.

In **English** we will be basing our learning on exciting stories about animals. Your child will also be developing their skills in these areas:

- Combining words to write sentences.
 - Writing sentences using finger spaces and a full stop.
 - Joining letters using cursive handwriting.
 - Identifying and using nouns.
- We have a daily focussed phonics session where children will revise and learn new sounds. Children will be investigating narrative and non-fiction styles of writing.

Ways you can help your child

- Please help your child with their reading by reading a couple of pages of their books with them four times a week. This helps them to gain a raffle ticket for our end of term draw to win a prize!
- Your child will have a caterpillar book to learn their sounds or words. These will be checked weekly.
- The homework project will be introduced before the half term break.
- A great resource you can use at home with your children is Phonics Play computer games. The children will be looking at phase three and phase five sounds. We love playing Buried Treasure!
