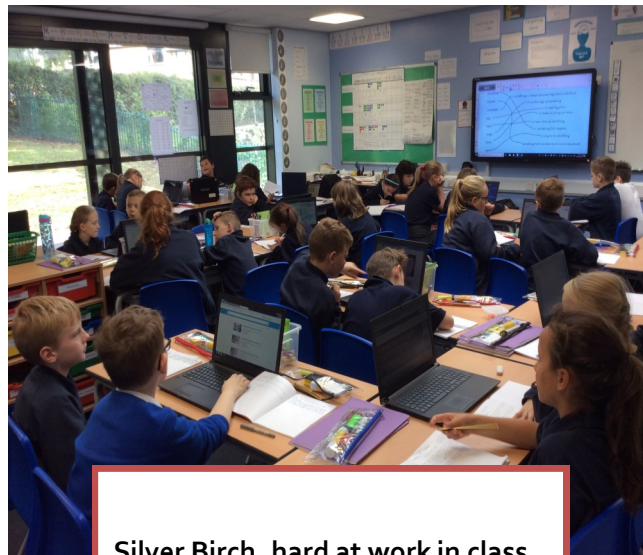
Year Six SATs are the week beginning 14<sup>th</sup> May. Please take no holidays during school time before this date or during the week of the tests.
