

# **Newsletter – Friday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022**

Dear Families,

A walk round school at the moment might lead to you picking up a hint of bad luck – some of our younger children have started practising Christmas songs in hushed tones ready for their performances in December. Ticketing details/allocations should have reached you by now – thank you for your patience as we grapple with various new electronic sign-up systems which will eventually prove more efficient for everyone in the future (... but take extra time to set up initially).

### **PERSISTENT ABSENCE**

The number of children at Hookstone Chase with less than 90% attendance this year (classed by the government as **persistent absentees**) is **nearly one in five (19%), more than double** the latest national figures on persistent absenteeism for primary schools (8.8% in 2020 - 21).

## Regular school attendance is absolutely vital.

Good attendance habits at primary school (i.e. over 95%) set the tone for building strong friendships, positive social skills and an excellent attitude to life-long learning.

We understand that there are explainable reasons why children may not attend school, but our school community faces many problems if pupils see non-attendance as normalised. All too often, patterns of poor attendance continue and deepen as children move to secondary school and into the world of work.

Many families will have received letters this week regarding notification about persistent absence: we will be monitoring this closely for **all pupils**, including those at risk of becoming persistent absentees (i.e. below 95% attendance).

## **HOOKSTONE CHASE COMMUNITY FORUM**

A huge thank you to the 9 parents/carers and school staff who attended our first Hookstone Chase Community Forum on Tuesday. It was really positive to hear from contrasting voices on the subject of **reporting to parents/carers** to help inform a review of our systems to benefit everyone.

In brief:

### What does happen?

- Parent/carer evenings twice a year (autumn and spring terms) then written reports to parents/carers in July
- o Some felt that reports could focus on their child better, rather than using generic report statements
- o Seeing children's work is welcomed this did not happen at the most recent parents' evening
- o Teachers typically spend many hours outside of the school day writing reports for their class

## What should happen?

- o Reports should be informative and focus on pupil progress (not merely on curriculum coverage)
- o Statutory guidelines on reports and parent/carer consultation events are vague/minimal
- Time critical communication about social/academic issues should be communicated proactively rather than simply at parent/carer events

## What could happen?

- o Curriculum information should be provided throughout the year to keep everyone in the loop
- The timing of written reports should link to parent/carer consultations
- Children's recorded learning could be shared with parents/carers at key times to allow them to see progress for themselves

In the coming weeks we will capture the wider school community's opinions on issues raised and solutions suggested. Our next meeting will be **January 17<sup>th</sup> at 4.30pm** and <u>all</u> are welcome to attend.
